- New York Oncology Hematology (NYOH) is the region's leading provider of cancer care services.
- With more than 400 employees and nine sites of service, NYOH has pioneered the development and growth of community-based cancer care in upstate New York.
- NYOH Amsterdam is one of the oldest cancer care programs in the NYOH network, celebrating 25 years of community based cancer care in Montgomery and Fulton Counties. It began as a one-room office at both Amsterdam Memorial Hospital and St. Mary's Hospital with a staff of two – a physician and a nurse. It has since evolved into a comprehensive cancer center with a staff of 35, located at 1700 RiverFront Center in Amsterdam.
- The patient care team at NYOH Amsterdam includes board certified medical and radiation oncologists, radiation therapists, oncology certified nurses, laboratory technologists and support personnel.
- Accredited by the Commission for Office Laboratory Accreditation and American College of Radiation Oncology, NYOH Amsterdam offers a variety of on-site services including intensity modulated radiation therapy (IMRT), pre-treatment ultrasound of the prostate and CT scanner for 3-D radiation simulation.
- In addition to the services offered at NYOH Amsterdam, other specialized services including stem cell transplant, Mammosite Radiation Therapy, High Dose Rate (HDR) Brachytherapy and genetic counseling are available within the NYOH network.
- NYOH is a member of the US Oncology network, the nation's largest health care services network devoted exclusively to cancer treatment and research. Through its affiliation with US Oncology, NYOH offers its patients access to the latest national and international research and clinical trials.
